CHAMBER FLAG	Flashlights

SAFETY / HANDLING
May not muzzle / sweep anyone while being handled (DQ)
All other safety rules apply: NDs, 180s, finger in trigger guard, dropped gun, safety on/off
Must use chamber flag (Not a DQ but an RO will help fix this if missing)
PCC must be carried upright (pointed down or up) with chamber flag inserted
PCC may be unbagged at the line and rebagged after stage
PCC may be transported on gun carts or slung on shoulder

START POSITION / WSB
Default start position is facing downrange, PCC loaded, Both hands on PCC, at <u>low ready or port arms</u> , muzzle pointed generally downrange, safety on, finger out of trigger guard
Low ready: PCC shouldered, muzzle at/below belt
Port arms: PCC stock on belt, muzzle above belt
Hands on marks means PCC muzzle on a mark (may be a PCC specific mark)
PCC may NOT start facing uprange regardless of WSB
Adhere to other parts of WSB as best as possible

Strong hand only
Shouldered on strong side and trigger pulled with strong hand (Essentially Freestyle)

Weak hand only
Shouldered on weak side and trigger pulled with weak hand
